U LIVING ON THE EDGE

What if, for one day, Jesus was to become you?

What if, for 24 hr. Jesus wakes up in your bed, walks in your shoes, lives in your house, and assumes your schedule? Your boss becomes His boss, your mother becomes His mother, and your pains and struggles become His? With one exception, **nothing about your life changes.** Your health doesn't change. Your circumstances don't change. Your schedule isn't altered. Your problems aren't solved. Only one change occurs.

Your heart gets the day off, and your life is led by the heart of Christ. His priorities govern your actions. His passions drive your decisions. His love directs your behavior.

What would you be like? Would people notice a change? Your family—would they see something new? Your coworkers—would they sense a difference? Your friends—would they detect more joy? Those who oppose you, or those who grate you like sandpaper, would they receive more mercy from the heart of Christ's heart than from yours.

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And you! How would you feel? What alternations would this transplant have on you? Your stress level? Your mood swings? Would you sleep better? How about your reaction to traffic delays? (Ouch!)

Would you still do what you had planned for the next 24 hours? Think about your schedule—commitments, engagements, appointments. With Jesus taking over your heart, would anything change?

Adjust the lens of your imagination until you have a clear picture of Jesus leading your life, then frame the image. What you see is what God wants. He wants you to think and act like Christ. (Phil. 2:5)

God's plan for you is nothing short of a new heart
